National News

The Home Office has published Standards for <u>Domestic Abuse Perpetrator Interventions</u>: <u>Overarching</u> <u>principles and practice guidelines for commissioning and delivering interventions for perpetrators</u> <u>of domestic abuse</u>.

<u>Promoting safer sleep for babies in high-risk groups in England</u> has been published by the NIHR. This project was funded by the NIHR Policy Research Programme.

Social Work England have published it's report <u>Social Work in England: State of the nation 2023</u>. The Centre of expertise on child sexual abuse has published <u>Key messages from research on the impacts of child sexual abuse</u>.

Tackling Child Exploitation (TCE) has published <u>Multi-agency practice principles for responding to</u> <u>child exploitation and extra-familiar harm</u> which is designed to support effective partnership working.

MFH Protocol and Trigger Plan

The Missing from Home Protocol has been launched across Pan Lancashire through the hard work of all the partners.
